

Alexander Frood - Ann Sinclair

Alexander Frood, born in Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire on 18 May 1836, son of [John Frood and Mary McIlquham](#).

Alexander is at Old Kirk Cottage, Cambusnethan on the 1841 and 1851 Census and at Cartside Farm, Cathcart, Renfrewshire on the 1861 Census.

Ann Sinclair, born in Bothwell, Lanarkshire c.1844, daughter of [Donald Sinclair and Ann Hartford](#).

Ann is in Carlisle Road, Chapelhall, Lanarkshire on the 1851 Census and is possibly at Malcolmwood Farm, Cambuslang, Lanarkshire on the 1861 Census. At the time of her marriage her address is given as 17 Montgomery Street, Glasgow.

Alexander and Ann were married in Kirkton, Blantyre, Lanarkshire on 10 December 1868.

Officiated by Robert Montgomery, Minister of the Free Church, Blantyre

Witnessed by Matthew Brown and Elizabeth Cowan.

Alexander and Ann are at Cartside Farm on the 1871 Census and at East End Farm, East Kilbride, Lanarkshire on the 1881 and 1891 Census.

On the 1901 Census, Alexander is at Duntiglennan Farm, Old Kilpatrick, Dunbartonshire and Ann is at East End Farm.

Alexander and Ann are at East End Farm on the 1911 Census.

CHILDREN

John Kerr Frood, born at Cartside of Dripps Farm, Cathcart, Renfrewshire on 22 October 1869.

John is at Cartside of Dripps Farm on the 1871 Census and at East End farm on the 1881 and 1891 Census. He is at Duntiglennan Farm, Duntocher at the time of his marriage.

John married Isabella Johnston Watt (b. New Kilpatrick, Stirlingshire on 23 October 1872), daughter of James Watt and Agnes Barr, at Bath Hotel, Bath Street, Glasgow on 25 June 1896. Isabella is at Milngavie Grain Mill, where her father was a Miller.

John and Isabella are at 3 Wellshot Cottages, Rutherglen, Lanarkshire on the 1901 Census, where John's occupation is Foreman Stableman.

John and Isabella possibly emigrated to Australia.

Ann Sinclair Froid, born at Cartside of Dripps Farm, Cathcart, Renfrewshire on 31 July 1871.

Ann is at East End Farm on the 1881 and 1891 Census.

[Ann married William Dickie](#) (b. Rutheran Farm, Glassford, Lanarkshire on 1 October 1871), son of [James Dickie and Margaret Weir](#), at East End Farm on 19 December 1899.

Ann and William are at Rigg Farm, Glassford on the 1901 and 1911 Census.

Ann died at Rigg Farm on 7 January 1919, age 47.

William died at Rigg Farm on 19 February 1930, age 58.

Mary McIlquham Froid, born at Cartside of Dripps Farm, Cathcart, Renfrewshire on 4 February 1873

Mary is at East End Farm, East Kilbride on the 1881 and 1891 Census.

Mary married Walter Harvie (b. Main Street, Duntocher, Dunbartonshire on 11 February 1874), Potato Merchant, son of Agnes Harvie, father's name unknown, at The Established Church Manse, Duntocher on 28 April 1896.

Mary and Walter are at 21 Old Street, Old Kilpatrick, Dunbartonshire on the 1901 Census.

Mary died at Harvie's Land, Duntocher on 19 January 1915, age 41.

Walter died in Ayr on 19 September 1947, age 73. His address is given as Erskine Villa, Duntocher, and his death was registered in Dunbartonshire.

Catherine Frood, born at East End Farm, East Kilbride, Lanarkshire on 22 October 1874.

Catherine is at East End Farm on the 1881 and 1891 Census, and at Duntiglennan Farm on the 1901 Census.

Catherine spent some time in New Zealand, staying with her uncle Donald Sinclair, her mother's brother. She is on the Electoral Roll for Wallace, Southland in 1928, staying at her uncle's house, Nightcaps.

Catherine returned to Scotland, arriving in Southampton on 21 March 1956 aboard the M.V. Rangitata, giving her intended address as 'Cardross, Dunbartonshire'.

Catherine died at Henry Brock Hospital, Dumbarton on 19 December 1958, age 84. Her usual address is Craddock House, Milton, Dunbartonshire.

Marion McIlquham Frood, born at East End Farm, East Kilbride, Lanarkshire on 17 July 1877.

Marion is at East End Farm on the 1881, 1891 and 1901 Census.

Marion married Joseph Telfer (b. Rothesay, Bute c.1877) of Ardrannan Farm, Tighnabruich, Argyll, son of William John Telfer and Ann Brown, at The Manse, East Kilbride on 15 November 1905.

Marion died at the Victoria Hospital Annex, Rothesay, Bute on 25 August 1973, age 96. Her usual address is Townhead, Rothesay.

Alexander Frood, born at East End Farm, East Kilbride, Lanarkshire on 20 November 1879.

Alexander is at East End Farm on the 1881, 1891 and 1901 Census. At the time of his marriage in 1906 he is at Dykehead Farm, East Kilbride.

Alexander married Bethia Macaulay (b. East Kilbride c.1879) of Hairmyres Farm, daughter of James Macaulay and Marion Johnston, at the Torrance Hotel, East Kilbride on 20 December 1906. Bethia is a granddaughter of [Alexander Johnston and Agnes Dick](#).

Alexander and Bethia moved to Essex, first to Spurriers Farm, Ingatestone

and then to Old Garlands Farm, Thurrock.

Bethia died at Old Garlands Farm on 8 January 1962, age 83.

Alexander died at Old Garlands Farm on 28 April 1963, age 83.

Elizabeth Froid, born at East End Farm, East Kilbride, Lanarkshire on 27 February 1882.

Elizabeth is at East End Farm on the 1891 and 1901 Census.

Elizabeth never married. She died at Erskine Villa, Duntocher, Dunbartonshire on 23 December 1961, age 79.

Walter Froid, born at East End Farm, East Kilbride, Lanarkshire on 30 May 1884.

Walter is at East End Farm on the 1891 and 1901 Census. At the time of his marriage in 1907 he is at Wester Kittochside Farm, East Kilbride.

Walter married Agnes George (b. c.1885), daughter of Sinclair George and Jane Shearer, at The Manse, East Kilbride on 25 December 1907. Walter's occupation is Carter.

Walter died at West Lodge, Cardross Park, Dunbartonshire on 28 July 1953, age 69.

Margaret Russell Froid, born at East End Farm, East Kilbride, Lanarkshire on 16 January 1887.

Margaret is at East End Farm on the 1891 and 1901 Census.

Margaret married James Smith (b.c.1886), son of John Smith and Helen Munn, at The Manse, Carmunnock, Lanarkshire on 24 January 1917.

James died at 42 Kilmailing Road, Cathcart, Lanarkshire on 3 April 1920, age 34.

Margaret was declared dead on arrival at County Hospital, Ayr on 10 October 1966, age 79. Her usual address is given as 30 Bellevue Crescent, Ayr.

DEATHS

Ann died at East End Farm on 21 February 1915, age 71.

Alexander died at 6 Kilmailing Road, Cathcart on 17 March 1918, age 81.
