

Alexander Frood - Ann Wilson

Alexander Frood, born at Milnmuir Farm, Carmichael, Lanarkshire c.1778, son of [Alexander Frood and Marion Symington](#).

Ann Wilson, born in Douglas, Lanarkshire c.1777, daughter of [John Wilson and June Moffat](#).

Alexander and Ann were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Carmichael on 7 December 1799 and in the parish of Douglas on 13 January 1799.

Alexander and Ann are at Ranald's Orchard, Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire on the 1841 and 1851 Census.

Ann, now widowed, is at Ranald's Orchard on the 1861 Census.

CHILDREN

Alexander Frood, born in Carmichael, Lanarkshire on 24 June 1800.

Alexander possibly emigrated to Canada, and died in Dundas, Ontario in 1885.

John Frood, born either in Douglas, Lanarkshire c.1805 or Lesmahagow, Lanarkshire, c.1800. Neither year seems particularly likely as they coincide with brothers Alexander (b. 1800) and James (b.1806). It is possible that 'John' is one of these two.

[John married Mary McIlquham](#) (b. Glasgow, Lanarkshire c.1803), daughter of [Walter McIlquham and Marion Williamson](#).

John and Mary are at Old Kirk Cottage, Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire on the 1841 and 1851 Census, and at Cartside Farm, Cathcart, Renfrewshire on the 1861 and 1871 Census.

Mary died in Clyde Street, Partick, Lanarkshire on 24 January 1872, age 68.

John died at East End Farm, East Kilbride, Lanarkshire on 1 December 1880, age 78.

Hugh Frood, born at Watchknowe Farm in Carmichael, Lanarkshire on 19 March 1804.

James Frood, born in Carmichael, Lanarkshire and baptised on 13 April 1806.

Mary Frood, born in Carmichael, Lanarkshire on 11 February 1809.

Mary is at Ranald's Orchard, Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire on the 1841, 1851 and 1861 Census.

Walter Frood, born in Douglas, Lanarkshire and baptised on 12 September 1813.

Walter married Jean Gemmel (b. Douglas, Lanarkshire c.1807). They were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Douglas on 31 May 1835.

Walter and Marion are in Stewart Street, Carluke, Lanarkshire on the 1841 Census, at Poniel Farm, Douglas on the 1851 Census, in Caledonian Road, Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire on the 1861 Census and at Whiterigg Farm, Kilbucho, Broughton and Glenholm, Peebleshire on the 1881 Census.

Walter, now widowed, is at White Ridge (possibly Whiterigg) Cottage, Lanark on the 1891 Census.

Marion Frood, born at Ponfeigh Place Farm, Douglas, Lanarkshire on 24 December 1815.

Marion married Arthur Fleming (b. Lanarkshire c. 1816-1820).

Marion and Arthur are in Bothwell Bridge, Bothwell, Lanarkshire on the 1841 Census. Arthur is employed as an Agricultural Labourer.

Marion, now widowed, is in Glasgow Road, Bothwell, Lanarkshire on the 1851 Census.

Marion married again, to Robert Mackie (b. Bothwell, Lanarkshire). They were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Bothwell, Lanarkshire on 10 December 1854.

Marion and Robert are in Glasgow Road, Bothwell on the 1861 Census, in Hewitt Close, Main Street, Bothwell on the 1871 Census, in Main Street, Bothwell on the 1881 Census and in Boyd's Land, Green Street, Bothwell on

the 1891 Census.

Marion died in Boyd's Land on 11 July 1892, age 76.

Robert died in Boyd's Land on 13 March 1894, age 91.

Ann Frood, born in Douglas, Lanarkshire and baptised on 28 June 1818.

DEATHS

Alexander died at East Ranald's Orchard, Cambusnethan, Lanarkshire on 28 August 1857, age 79.

Ann died at Ranald's Orchard on 1 June 1867, age 90.
