Francis Dickie - Margaret Campbell

Francis Dickie, born at Killochhead Farm, Mauchline, Ayrshire on 16 June 1758, son of Alexander Dickie and Marion Barr.

Margaret Campbell's place and date of birth and parents' names are unknown. Her eldest son is named Hugh Campbell, which is possibly her father's name. On her marriage bann, Margaret is said to be 'of Meikleyard', which is possibly Meikleyard Farm in Galston, Ayrshire. Hugh Campbell was the proprietor of Meikleyard Farm in 1803.

Francis and Margaret were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Mauchline on 28 April 1789.

Francis's occupation is Master Joiner, according to his daughter Jane's death record.

CHILDREN

Hugh Campbell Dickie, born at Cockmoss Farm, Galston, Ayrshire on 4 April 1790.

Hugh is possibly in Shore Street, Port Glasgow, Renfrewshire on the 1851 Census, where he is a Weigher for HM Customs. He is married to Mary, surname unknown, who was born in Ayrshire c.1803.

Grace Dickie, born in Galston, Ayrshire on 27 May 1792.

Grace's birth is recorded as 'Grizzel', a common variant of Grace. This also appears in records of her children's births.

Grace married Mungo Bryson (b. Strathaven, Lanarkshire c.1794).

Grace and Mungo are in Low Whiteflatt Farm, Sorn, Ayrshire on the 1851 Census.

Grace died in Sorn in 1858, age 67.

James Dickie, born in Galston, Ayrshire and baptised on 13 July 1794.

David Dickie, born in Galston, Ayrshire and baptised on 7 November 1796.

Marion Dickie, born in Galston, Ayrshire on 9 March 1799.

Margaret Dickie, born in Galston, Ayrshire and baptised on 15 November 1801.

Margaret married David McKerrow (b. Auchinleck, Ayrshire c.1793). They were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Sorn, Ayrshire on 3 September 1830.

Margaret and David are at Roadinghead Farm, Auchinleck on the 1851 and 1861 Census.

Margaret died, probably at Roadinghead Farm, on 20 October 1862, age 60.

David is at Roadinghead Farm on the 1871 and 1881 Census. He died there on 18 July 1884, age 91.

Francis Dickie, born in Galston, Ayrshire and baptised on 16 December 1806.

Francis married Susan McLelland (b. Kilmarnock, Ayrshire c.1810). They were proclaimed for marriage in the parish of Kilmarnock, Ayrshire on 31 October 1837.

Francis and Susan are in Sandbed Street, Kilmarnock on the 1841 Census, in Kilmarnock on the 1851 Census, and in Clark Street, Kilmarnock on the 1861, 1871 and 1881 Census. Francis's occupation is Cabinet Maker.

Francis died at 9 Clark Street on 10 November 1882, age 75.

Jane Dickie, born in Galston, Ayrshire on 12 December 1806.

<u>Jane married James Weir</u> (b. Auchinleck, Ayrshire c.1797), son of <u>Robert Weir and Margaret McKinlay</u>. She was his second wife.

Jane and James are at Welltrees Farm, Auchinleck on the 1851 Census and at Blackside Farm, Sorn, Ayrshire on the 1861 and 1871 Census.

James died at Blackside Farm on 15 March 1878, age 81.

Jane is in Ynyscynhaiarn, Caernarvonshire on the 1891 Census.

Jane died at Blackside Farm on 10 March 1886, age 79.

Mary Dickie, born in Galston, Ayrshire and baptised on 14 May 1809.
