James married Christina Ewan Currie (b. Carnock, Fife on 14 March 1855), daughter of James Currie and Christina Mitchell, in Cowdenbeath, Fife on 31 December 1880.

Margaret and David are in Blairadam, Dunfermline on the 1891 Census and

in Kingseat, Dunfermline on the 1901 Census.

David died at 64 Main Street, Kingseat on 29 March 1932, age 75.

Margaret died at 48 Main Street, Kingseat on 3 April 1943, age 84.

Mary died in Parkneuk on 9 July 1915, age 47.

John died at 3 Parkneuk on 15 September 1924, age 63.

Archibald Carmichael, born in Dunfermline, Fife on 1 June 1863.

Archibald is at 11 South Row, Dunfermline on the 1871 Census, at 40 Parkneuk on the 1881 Census and at 4 Crystal Row, Parkneuk on the 1891 Census.

George Carmichael, born in Dunfermline, Fife on 26 June 1865.

George is at 11 South Row, Dunfermline on the 1871 Census and at 40 Parkneuk on the 1881 Census.

George married Jeanie Cruikshanks Veitch (b. Sinclairton, Fife on 19 August 1867), daughter of James Veitch and Helen Dye, in Dunfermline in 1887.

George and Jeanie are at 151 Baldridgeburn, Dunfermline on the 1891 Census.

Jeanie, now widowed, is at 111 Baldridgeburn on the 1901 Census.

Catherine Carmichael, born in Dunfermline, Fife on 27 July 1867.

Catherine is at 11 South Row, Dunfermline on the 1871 Census, at 40 Parkneuk on the 1881 Census and at 4 Crystal Row, Parkneuk on the 1891 Census.

Catherine married Erskine Hunter (b. Dunfermline, Fife on 16 May 1864), Coal Miner, son of Alexander Hunter and Elspeth Templeman, in Parkneuk, Dunfermline on 7 October 1892.

Catherine and Erskine are at 117 Whitemyre, Dunfermline on the 1901 Census.

Adam Carmichael, born in Dunfermline, Fife on 11 March 1871.

Adam is at 11 South Row, Dunfermline on the 1871 Census, at 40 Parkneuk on the 1881 Census, at 162 Oxford Street, Govan, Lanarkshire on the 1891 Census and in Munster Square, St Pancras, London on the 1901 Census. His occupation is Tailor.

Helen died at 204 Baldridgeburn, Dunfermline on 13 August 1904, age 77.
